Below are the 9 themes we will also be covering, one for each week of our program.

Earth's Four Spheres

Week 1: 6/9 - 6/13

Planet Earth is our home. Students learn about plants, animals, weather, climate, oceans, and the seasons. They will gain a greater awareness of their environment, helping them to understand the importance of taking care of our planet.

Money (Financial Literacy)

Week 2: 6/16 - 6/20

Understanding money equips our students with the confidence, knowledge, and skills to manage their finances effectively. Developing good money habits is a critical skill that will help children thrive in today's world. Where does money come from? How can I use it wisely? How do I save money? This foundational knowledge will empower your child for life.

Life Skills

Week 3: 6/23 - 6/27

Life skills are necessary for survival, self-sufficiency, and productivity in everyday life. For children, it's important to start learning these skills early so they have time to practice and develop them as they grow. Understanding etiquette, manners, decorum, personal hygiene, and body language helps children form good habits that last a lifetime.

STEMsters Week 4: 6/30 - 7/4

This module bursts with incredible science facts about the way our world works. From biology, chemistry, physics and natural history, students will discover incredible secrets, awesome theories and conduct fun experiments as they embark on their journey of scientific discovery!
